Truck plows through home

A predawn accident Monday left a Young Harris home in shambles after a logging truck plowed through the one-story older home off U.S. Highway 76 in Young Harris, Ga.

Rescue crews responded to the 6 a.m. call and arrived on scene to find an empty logging truck owned by A & M Trucking, of Westminster, S.C. in the middle of the home. Three adults and three children were reportedly asleep at the time of the impact and were not injured.



A tractor trailer logging truck owned by A&M Trucking out of Westminster S.C. came to rest in the middle of a home in Young Harris, Ga. The driver was transported to Union General Hospital and his condition is unknown. No one in the home was injured.

The road near the accident site curves and the truck appeared to have missed the curve. According to news reports the truck split the house in two. The truck driver was transported to Union General Hospital.

The cause of the accident is still under investigation and details, including names, have not been released by the Georgia Highway Patrol as of press time Wednesday.
